Introduction

1. By an application filed on 14 January 2021, the Applicant contests the "decision not to take any action on [her] complaint of abuse of authority" against the Executive Director, Office of Administration of Justice ("OAJ") and the Principal Registrar, OAJ.

- 2. On 15 February 2021, the Respondent filed his reply, *inter alia* challenging the receivability of the application.
- 3. On 3 April 2023, the above-mentioned case was assigned to the undersigned Judge.
- 4. By Order No. 28 (GVA/2023) of 4 April 2023, the Tribunal:
 - a. Gave the Applicant an opportunity to file a rejoinder; and
 - b. Convoked the parties to a case management discussion ("CMD").
- 5. On 18 April 2023, the Applicant filed a rejoinder.
- 6. On 26 April 2023, a CMD was held with the participation, in person, of the Applicant and Counsel for the Respondent.
- 7. By Order No. 41 (GVA/2023) of 28 April 2023, the Tribunal ordered the Respondent to file his comments on the receivability arguments raised by the Applicant in her rejoinder.
- 8. On 5 May 2023, the Respondent filed his response to Order No. 41 (GVA/2023).

Consideration

9. Having considered the parties' filings and their oral submissions at the CMD, the Tribunal considers itself sufficiently informed to render its judgment without the need for additional disclosure of evidence or the holding of a hearing on the merits.

10. As conveyed to the parties at the CMD, the Tribunal will rule in its judgment on the issue of the receivability of the application that the Respondent raised.

 - b. The Tribunal will proceed to adjudicate the matter and deliver its Judgment based on the papers before it.
