Introduction

1. On 28 April 2023, the Applicant, a staff member of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (“ESCAP”), filed an application contesting the decision to abolish the post he encumbered and not to renew his fixed-term appointment beyond 30 June 2023.
2. On 5 June 2023, the Respondent filed his reply.
3. On 3 July 2023, the Applicant filed his rejoinder.
4. On 27 February 2024, the present case was assigned to the undersigned Judge.

Consideration

5. Having examined the parties’ submissions to date and the evidence on record, the Tribunal finds that it is fully informed on the matter and that the case can be determined without holding a hearing. Consequently, the parties can proceed to file their closing submissions.

Conclusion

6. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure, it is ORDERED THAT by **Tuesday, 14 May 2024**, the parties shall file their respective closing submission, which shall:
 - a. Exclusively refer to the evidence already on file; and
 - b. Not exceed 10 pages, using font Times New Roman, font size 12 pts and 1.5 line spacing.
