Background

1. On 17 January 2022, the Tribunal issued Judgment No. UNDT/2022/004 and accordingly, closed Case No. UNDT/NBI/2020/096.
2. On 9 February 2022, the Applicant filed a motion for interim measures pending proceedings pursuant to art. 10.2 of the Dispute Tribunal's Statute in the same case.
3. On 14 February 2022, the Respondent filed a response to the Applicant's motion.

Deliberations

4. Article 10.2 of the UNDT Statute stipulates that "at any time during the proceedings, the Dispute Tribunal may order an interim measure, which is without appeal, to provide temporary relief to either party, where the contested administrative decision appears prima facie to be unlawful, in cases of particular urgency, and where its implementation would cause irreparable damage. This temporary relief may include an order to suspend the implementation of the contested administrative decision, except in cases of appointment, promotion or termination."
5. As reflected above, the proceedings in this case were concluded by Judgment No. UNDT/2022/004 and the case has since been closed. There are no proceedings going on in this case before the Dispute Tribunal.
6. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

7. The Applicant's motion for interim measures is rejected.
8. The Applicant is directed to always first seek leave of the Tribunal before filing other additional motions or applications in this matter.
