The Application and Procedural History

1. On 23 March 2023, the Applicant filed an application seeking reinstatement of his career pursuant to ST/SGB/2023/1 (Staff Regulations and Staff Rules, including provisional Staff Rules, of the United Nations).

2. The application was served on the Respondent with a deadline of 26 April 2023 to file his reply. On 29 March 2023, the Respondent filed a motion to have receivability determined as a preliminary matter and requested suspension of the reply deadline until there is a decision on his motion.

ORDER

3. The Respondent's motion is granted. The deadline for the reply is suspended until the Tribunal decides on the receivability issue.

4. On or before 19 April 2023, the Applicant is ordered to file a response to the Respondent's motion of 29 March 2023. The response should not exceed three pages in length.
