## Introduction

1. The Applicant is a former Field Security Assistant at the G-4 level with United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon. On 20 June 2023, he filed an application in which he contests the decision to impose on him the disciplinary measure of separation from service with compensation in lieu of notice and without termination indemnity pursuant to staff rule 10.2 for his alleged involvement in a verbal and physical assault on 4 September 2021, in Beirut, Lebanon.
2. The Respondent filed a reply on 26 July 2023 in which he contends that the application has no merit and should be rejected.
3. In view of the submissions by the parties, the Tribunal has decided to hold a case management discussion ("CMD").
4. The purpose of the CMD is to discuss the issues and evidence to be presented at a hearing and to schedule that hearing.
