Introduction

1. By Judgment No. UNDT/2021/154 dated 16 December 2021, the Tribunal found the contested decision unlawful and ordered the parties to file their closing statements on relief remedies in the following sequential order: 6 January (Applicant), 20 January (Respondent) and 25 January 2022 (Applicant). The Tribunal further instructed the parties that unless otherwise ordered, on receipt of the latest of the aforementioned statements or at the expiration of the provided time limits, the Tribunal would adjudicate on the matter and deliver Judgment based on the papers filed on record.

Consideration

2. After having closely perused the closing statements of the parties, the Tribunal finds that additional information and documentation is required for rendering the judgment on relief. This concerns all the Applicant's employment-related actual net salaries/incomes, including from consultancies or other temporary and/or one-time engagements, after the termination of his appointment with the World Meteorological Organization ("WMO") on 9 May 2018.

3. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 4 February 2022**, the Applicant is to provide information on and documentation from all his employment-related actual net salaries/incomes, including from consultancies or other temporary and/or one-time engagements, after his appointment with WMO was terminated on 9 May 2018.
