Order No. 135 (NY/2023)

Introduction

1. By Order No. 131 (NY/2023) dated 21 November 2023, the Tribunal issued the following instructions (see paras. 11 and 12):

... The hearing shall be held on 14 and 15 December 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., New York time, via MS Teams at which the Applicant and a witness from the Administration will provide testimonies.

... By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 8 December 2023**, the Respondent is to file a witness statement, and so should the Applicant file his witness statement.

2. On 1 December 2023, the Respondent filed a "motion for Tribunal's leave to call two (not just one) witnesses".

Consideration

3. Pursuant to arts. 17 on giving oral evidence and 18 on admissibility of evidence under the Rules of Procedure, the Tribunal shall allow the Respondent's motion to call two witnesses instead of one to give oral testimony.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

5. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 8 December 2023**, the Respondent is to file the witness statements of the proposed two witnesses, and so should the Applicant file his witness statement. The trial shall take place on 13, 14 and 15 December 2023 from 9.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. New York time.
