DENMARK

The Danish Ambition:

- Limit rise in global temperature to 1.5 degrees and achieve net zero by 2050.
- Lead by example, reduce national CO2-emissions by 70% in 2030 (1990-level) and support energy transition in third countries.
- Reduce national CO2-emissions by 50-54% (1990-level) in 2025.

Nationally:

- Expect to cover 100% of the Danish electricity consumption with renewable energy by 2028.
- Up-scale offshore wind by potentially up to 12 GW with the construction of the world's first two "energy islands".
- Political agreement on phase out of oil and gas extraction by 2050 and immediate end to existing and new licensing rounds.
- Committed to EU targets on energy transition, the European climate law and the implementation of the European Green Deal.

Internationally:

- Export a considerable amount of green electricity from the future energy islands to our neighbouring countries.
- Support energy transition in 16 countries through bilateral cooperation sharing Danish expertise and know-how.
- Increase ODA contributions to accelerate universal access to electricity and clean cooking in Sub-Saharan Africa.
- Launch the Beyond Oil and Gas Alliance to mobilize decision-makers for ending oil and gas production. Work for people-centred green transitions.
- Strengthen international cooperation on offshore wind to massively upscale renewable energy and achieve net-zero emissions.
